




The amount of heritage site recorded in the database so far:

- 19 584 Cultural heritage listed and non listed immovable objects
- 8 Protection zones
- 2600 Cultural heritage movable objects
- 10 Wall paintings
- 3 Stone carving
- 17 Museum-reserves/museums
- 1458 Activities
- 213 567 Documents















- From 20000 immovable heritage monuments and objects almost none has exact boundaries defined;
- Around 8000 doesn't have exact geographic coordinates;
- · Almost 95% doesn't have accurate documentation;
- · On around 99% there isn't photogrammetric or scanned material;
- · Gaps in educational system in cultural heritage field.















Future goals

- Get exact locations for all the immovable cultural heritage monument and object recorded until now;
- Create standardized documentation on all of them;
- Capacity building for experts to utilize modern technologies for documenting;
- Define exact boundaries for each site;
 - Create Photogrammetric or scanned data on most of them for planning further activates to protect, manage and promote the heritage.
- Standardize all the documentation for the activities on cultural heritage (conservation, restoration, archaeological surveys or excavations and etc);
- Create proper management or conservation plan for each one;
- Define boundaries not only for single sites but also for cultural landscapes for further protection and management.
