<b>Course Aim and Objectives</b>	<p>The aim of the course is to focus on sustainable approaches to the planning, development and management of tourism.</p> <p>The main objectives are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ To introduce concepts and tools of sustainable tourism management,</li> <li>✓ To identify global tourism stakeholders and sustainable tourism organizations,</li> <li>✓ To present international case studies that demonstrates progress in sustainable tourism issues worldwide,</li> <li>✓ to present the key issues of sustainability and the principles and practices that affect them,</li> <li>✓ to analyze tourism impacts on sustainable development,</li> <li>✓ to introduce sustainable practices adopted by different sectors of the tourism industry,</li> <li>✓ to evaluate economic, socio-cultural and environmental sustainability,</li> <li>✓ to assess cultural and natural resources,</li> <li>✓ to evaluate tourism facilities and infrastructures,</li> <li>✓ to develop sustainable tourism development plan for Armenia.</li> </ul>			
<b>Short Description</b>	<p>Tourism is an industry with product based on environmental consumption, both natural and man-made. Continued growth in tourism has led many nations, as well as tourism businesses, to recognize the need to develop policies and programs that protect and conserve precious tourism resources. In this course, students will examine sustainable tourism development programs and industry best practices to better understand tourism's positive and negative impacts, and the need to protect, sustain, and conserve tourism destinations for future generations. The course includes the following modules: Inventory and tourism assessment of cultural resources; Tools for tourism enhancement of cultural heritage; Tourism facilities and infrastructures.</p>

You should use the feedback provided to improve the quality of your work on subsequent assignments.</p> <p>During the course two midterm papers and one final paper should be prepared and presented.</p> <p><b>Assessment:</b> Total score is 20 points. Two midterm papers (8 points): 1st midterm paper - 3 points, 2nd paper - 5 points, final paper - 8 points, Active participation in classroom and homework assignments during the whole period – 4 points.</p> <p>Evaluation of papers will be done according to the following criteria: form of the paper – 10%, paper content and relevance to topic – 45%, oral presentation – 45%.</p>

*Methods:* SWOT, Survey, research, benchmarking, brainstorming, discussion, debates, etc.

Group or Individual Project 1: Analyze the international best experience of sustainable tourism development.

Group Project 2: Pick a destination in Armenia of your choice. Examine what stage of the destination life cycle it is in, what types of tourists it attracts and what major impact tourism has on the environment, society and culture as well as the local economy. Describe these through the lenses of various stakeholders such as local people, tourists, and multinational corporations. At a minimum give the perspective of three different stakeholders. Explain the interrelatedness of these stakeholders and issues. Then describe what can or is being done in the destination to enhance sustainability in these three areas.

Group Project 3 (for final exam): Evaluate the current state of tourism in Armenia, the benefits and threats of tourism by economic, cultural and environmental aspects. Analyze the natural and cultural heritage of Armenia and their touristic value. Analyze the existing touristic infrastructures in Armenia. Conduct SWOT for evaluating sustainable tourism in Armenia and as a result elaborate a sustainable tourism development plan for Armenia (the same may be done for different regions or cities of Armenia).
